Welcome and Absences	<p>JP opened the meeting welcoming members.</p> <p>Apologies were received from Jonathan Hulley, Joe Stratford, Gill Morgan and Peter Lerner.</p>	
Agree Minutes of Previous Meeting	<p>Minutes from the 08th October 2019 Committee Meeting were approved by AS and seconded by CM.</p>	
Chairman's Reports	<p>Confirmation that the grant funding of £8,993 had been received into the bank account. Forum will need to seek further funding at a later stage.</p> <p><u>Local Plan</u> Attending the hearing on 14th November and it was confirmed that the County Council will be implementing a smart motorway between Junctions 10 & 11 within the next 2/3 years.</p> <p>Decision on the Local Plan to be made by the end of the year and this will be subject to a list of requirements to be met concerning Longcross</p> <p>JP met with David Adams at Tarmac who is keen to pursue the land by industrial ground for industrial units. Tarmac are suggesting donating the lake and to donate capital sum for the upkeep back to the community.</p> <p>JP met with Sandra Mueller, the General Manager at Great Fosters, her imminent concerns are regarding the illegal development across the road from the hotel.</p>	
Initial Consultation & Questionnaire	<p>Residential questionnaire is now completed and loaded onto the website. Business questionnaire is currently being road tested, and will be reviewed and uploaded onto the website over the next few days.</p>	

	<p>Discussions were held for the initial consultation go-live dates, and it was agreed for a “soft launch” during December with a “hard launch” during January.</p> <p>Also ensuring that the consultation period is open at the time of the WRA AGM, on the 19th January. JP will be presenting the NP, where he will encourage attendees to complete the on-line survey prior to end of January.</p>	
Advertising	<p>Connection Magazine is running the NP advert in Decembers and January’s issues.</p> <p>Adverts will also be live in The Villager on the 13th December and 10th January, with both mpu’s going live on these dates also.</p> <p>Posters and flyers are currently being printed and will be ready in the next few days. Options need to be looked at with regards to the best way to secure the posters to the trees or stakes in the ground.</p> <p>JamesP, agreed to erect A3 laminated posters at suitable sites within the Estate.</p> <p>JT suggested WRA Constituency Representatives encourage their own Constituencies to complete the surveys.</p> <p>It was agreed to have some banners produced to be displayed across the village, in particular, on the railings by the train station to be seen by the Christchurch traffic and also commuters from the station.</p> <p>NP website link will be included in the Wentworth Residents Association end of year letter that is to be inserted into the Wentworth Estate Roads Committee end of year correspondence, this will be mailed out to over 600 households across the village.</p>
